Forgetfulness

It's obviously very important to remember to do Mitzvot and to remember how to correctly do the Mitzvot. If we forget to do a Mitzvah the result will be that we will forget to do yet another Mitzvah. And if we forget how to do a Mitzvah correctly, the result will be that we will forget how to correctly fulfill yet another Mitzvah.

This truth is derived from the redundancy in words in Parshat Ekev, "V'haya Im Sha'choach Tishkach Et Hashem Elokecha..." The words "Im Tishkach..." would have sufficed. However, the Torah wishes to tell us that the forgetting of a Jewish way of life is as easy a slide as that: forget one and you might forget them all. [Mechilta, Beshalach]

This idea is similar to that of "the reward of a Mitzvah is a (chance to perform another) Mitzvah and the award of an Av-erah is (the felt need to violate another) Av-erah".
