Saved From (By) the Sword

Our understanding of how Moshe Rabbeinu was able to escape from the Pharaoh's clutches is augmented by information provided by Chazal. After being arrested and charged with murder of an Egyptian task master, Moshe was condemned to die by the sword. The executioner brought the sword to as close as Moshe's neck! Miraculously, the sword slipped or swung away from Moshe's neck and struck the executioner instead. The blow proved fatal to the would-be executioner, thus the opportunity to flee. Moshe escaped thanks to the very sword that had been intended for him.

Chazal bid that we each learn from these events by which the sword failed to kill Moshe. The sword reaching Moshe's neck serves as a metaphor for the tragedy that seems inevitable. Even when there appears to be no hope, we must try to recognize that there is. Our hopes for salvation are in the Almighty whose mercy can spare us even in the last moment.
